90. Based on the defendant's reported financial information, it would appear he has the ability to pay a fine.

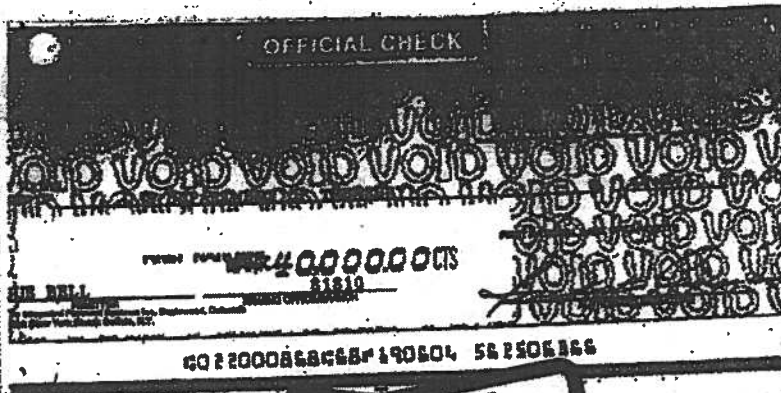
