JUDGMENT

This matter on for hearing on the 25th day of August, 2003, for trial on the merits on an action to annul the Judgment of Interdiction of WILFRED BELL and, alternatively, to terminate or limit the interdiction of WILFRED BELL and further, to remove the Curatrix and Undercuratrix of WILFRED BELL.

PRESENT: WILFRED BELL, and his court-appointed attorney, Ricky Lafleur; Plaintiff, ROY BELL, and his attorneys, Mark Sikes and Tammy Parker; and Defendants, LOVENIA MULL and DEBRA MULL, and their attorney, David Kaufman.

The Court, considering the agreement of the parties and their desire to have said agreement incorporated into a judgment of this Court and their acknowledgment that no appeal from this Judgment may be filed and further, considering the law to be in favor of the parties and their desire for a Judgment and finding it to be in the best interest of WILFRED BELL, renders the following Judgment:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that WILFRED BELL will remain interdicted subject to the following special conditions:

1. WILFRED BELL will be physically relocated to an appropriate nursing home facility the Lafayette, Louisiana area as soon as practical, where he shall remain until further order of this Court;
 2. The parties, ROY BELL and LOVENIA BELL, will each bear one-half (1/2) of the costs associated with transporting WILFRED BELL from New Orleans to Lafayette, in accordance with his relocation;

juridical act, including but not limited to, having a checking account, signing promissory notes, transferring property or otherwise to incur debt for his own account or legally bind himself and/or his estate.

4. All family members and friends of WILFRED BELL shall have the right to visit WILFRED BELL at the nursing home in accordance with the rules of the nursing home and with due regard to WILFRED BELL'S health status and his desire to visit with that person at the time, and such visitation shall not require either the permission of or notice to the Curatrix or Undercuratrix;
5. WILFRED BELL shall always be supervised when in the presence of minor children;
6. Adult family members may, subject to the rules of the nursing home and with due regard for WILFRED BELL'S health status and treatment requirements, take WILFRED BELL on daily outings from the nursing home and such visitation shall not require either the permission of or notice to the Curatrix or Undercuratrix;
7. The Curatrix shall remain Lovenia Mull, but the current Undercuratrix, Debra Mull, is hereby removed and Ruby Bell, Mr. Bell's daughter, is hereby named Undercuratrix and shall execute and file the required Oath within the delays allowed by law;
8. The Curatrix and/or Undercuratrix are hereby specifically prohibited from transferring property of WILFRED BELL, borrowing money on behalf of WILFRED BELL, incurring any debt on behalf of WILFRED BELL, (other than the cost of the nursing home and necessities not provided by the nursing home within its monthly charge), as well as, filing any suit on behalf

of WILFRED BELL including but not limited to those
suits that may result in the recovery of assets by or
on behalf of WILFRED BELL, without prior approval of
this Court; and

9. That ROY BELL and LOVENIA MULL will each be responsible
for one-half(1/2) of the monthly cost incurred by or on
behalf of WILFRED BELL in excess of his social security
income up to a maximum of \$100.00 per month,
i.e., \$50.00 per party.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that each of the
parties, i.e., ROY BELL and LOVENIA MULL, will be responsible for
one-half(1/2) of the court costs, said court costs to include the
cost of transporting WILFRED BELL to trial on the 25th day of
August, 2003, as well as, the court-approved fee of the attorney
appointed to represent WILFRED BELL.
