5 And, we had the diesel tank that was dripping and leaking,  
6 as well, so I started getting that fixed.

7 Q. You had a diesel tank there for what?

8 A. To run the deep water well, and the John Deere tractor and  
9 any other tractors, and the combines during crop season.

10 Q. Now, in addition to what you've just described, did you  
11 have any responsibility with regard to getting the supplies for  
12 the water well?

13 A. Yes. Daddy did some of that early on, and the pumping  
14 fees, that was to pay him to watch the deep water well during  
15 the pumping season, because it is a 50-year old well, it's a  
16 little fragile.

17 Then daddy didn't want to do -- well, actually, I found  
18 out what he was doing with the money, so I stopped paying him,  
19 and he stopped seeing to the pump. So, that put the burden on  
20 Kenneth, and I would occasionally go by and make sure there was  
21 oil enough in there. If I saw, you know, that he might have  
22 needed some, because he's a diabetic and really having a rough  
23 time, I would occasionally bring supplies there. I would pick  
24 up supplies, as well, at the Southwest Farm and Supply.

25 Q. Did you ever accompany Mr. Gaspard to check the fields
